## Get Support for Heating Costs This Winter

The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is here to help Pennsylvanians stay warm this winter. The 2024-2025 LIHEAP season offers financial assistance to qualifying households to help cover heating costs during the cold months.

#### What LIHEAP Offers

LIHEAP provides cash grants to assist with heating bills and crisis grants for emergency situations where you're in immediate danger of losing your heat.



- Cash Grants: These grants help with your heating bills and are sent directly to your energy provider. They range from \$300 to \$1,000 based on income and household size.
- Crisis Grants: If you're facing an energy emergency, such as a furnace breakdown or having your heat turned off, crisis grants can provide additional funds.

#### Who Can Qualify?

Eligibility for LIHEAP is based on income and household size. You do not need to repay these grants.

#### **Season Dates**

The LIHEAP season runs from **November 1, 2024, to April 15, 2025**. However, funding is limited, so apply early to ensure you receive assistance if you qualify. Stay warm and safe this winter! ## Attorney General Warns of Phishing Scammers Claiming 'Fraudulent Activity'

The Office of Attorney General is alerting Pennsylvanians about a phishing scam involving claims of fraudulent activity on a person's bank account in order to access personal data and information.

Oftentimes, the scammers will provide a telephone number for the target to call or instruct the target to reply to an email or text message.



The scammers then request login credentials to financial accounts, account numbers and other personal identifiable information, such as your Social Security number and date of birth.

Financial institutions will never call you asking for your account information or login credentials through a telephone call, text message or email.

If you receive such a call, email or text, do not respond. Instead, you should contact the number on the back of your debit or credit card or contact your financial institution's local branch office and verify if they made the contact.

If you are a victim of a phishing scam, please inform the <u>Office of Attorney General's Bureau of Consumer Protection here</u> or by emailing <u>scams@attorneygeneral.gov</u> or calling 1-800-441-2555.
